Local Karting Success

The Burns name is well-known in Winton with Chris and Rebecca being the owners of Winton Flooring Xtra.

Now it is son Luca who is making a name for himself at National level in karting.

Luca started racing at age 8, under the wing of John Keast.

After 5 years of fantastic results throughout NZ, Luca pulled the pin at age 13 when his weight, 12kg heavier than has rivals, made him uncompetitive and there was no other class in which he could compete.

Four years later, at the age of 17 Luca decided to return to Karting as a hobby however four months in John Keast took him to Dunedin for the South Island Champs. John enlisted Taylor Harte, a talented driver, to "run" Luca. Taylor was impressed at Luca's performance suggesting to his father Dane, to approach Luca to join Dane Harte Racing Team.

Dane, previously the Crew Chief for Indy Cars in the US, is based in Tauranga. Luca races predominantly in the North Island where the "Dane Harte Racing" team demand results!

Dane defined Luca as "natural talent" and "the best way to describe Luca's progress in the last 9 months especially, would be phenomenal"

moving from mid pack to battling it out with some of the best drivers in the country.

Luca races in Rotax Max Light and KZ2 Karts under the umbrella of WPK Karts, backed by Indy Car legend Will Power. In an event in Nelson recently he proudly stood on the podium in both classes and broke the long-standing lap record.

Limehills Satellite School for Mitey

imehills School Senior Teacher, Belinda Brown, and Southland District Councillor, Margie Ruddenklau are working together to seek funding for a powerful mental health education initiative to be delivered to Southland Primary Schools.

Mitey has been established by the Sir John Kirwan Foundation to address New Zealand's poor mental health statistics. On average 1.5 New Zealander's die of suicide each day.

Mitey supports schools to deliver a New Zealand specific research driven approach to mental health education for Years 1-8, aligned with the New Zealand Curriculum. A trained coach is dedicated to the school to lead a high level of support to embed Mitey across the school community. (See www.mitey.org.nz. for more information.)

Currently Mitey is only being delivered in Auckland through trained coaches, with our local Limehills School implementing Mitey as a satellite school.

The drive is now to get more Southland schools involved.

The goal is to have a trained coach in Southland to create transformational change, deliver Mitey and embed mental health wellbeing into schools so there is a mental health education 'infrastructure' across Southland. Every child in Southland will develop the knowledge and tools to safeguard and nurture their mental wellbeing and to help others to do the same.

There is already interest from over a dozen schools in Southland who want to be involved with Mitey to start in 2022.

We are seeking funding to deliver Mitey in Southland which includes a Mitey coach, logistics and management support. Using a social impact investment approach, we can deploy Mitey across Southland through a collective of Southland partners and stakeholders with ongoing support from the Sir John Kirwan Foundation.

We have set up a meeting with Sir John Kirwan & CEO, Tim Corbett for Wednesday 17 Nov at 7pm

If Covid levels permit, they will be in Southland in person, if not the meeting will be via a Zoom conference. If anybody would like to know more information about the meeting and funding opportunities, please see the contact details below.


