

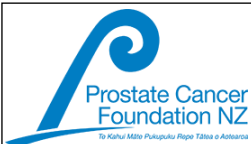

The initial coffee groups will cover information on baby and sleep cues from our community Karitane nurse , A session on baby brain development and the importance of the first 1000 days from Maree from the early childhood team at southern REAP , and support and information on breast, mixed and bottle feeding. The coffee groups cost a gold coin donation and are held at our comfy Plunket rooms with feeding chairs, self weigh facilities , and a baby change area.
