Over the winter months I have been running soup and chat luncheons for the Seniors Citizens in their clubrooms on John Street. We have heard about Jimmy and Bev Pratts trip to Alaska, Jeannie Peebles busy life and last week Senior Constable Jim Mangos talked about the comings and goings at the Winton Police Station. These have been enjoyed by all that have come along and we will run them again next winter.

My committee and I had the opportunity to volunteer at the final farmers meal for the year last Wednesday night. The combined community groups, churches and volunteers that combine to put these meals on the table each Wednesday evening are to be commended for the planning and organisation. Large numbers of people enjoy a home style meal and friendly banter during this busy calving and lambing season. Hats off to all of you that are responsible, you are doing a fantastic job. Also, to all of the businesses that are supporting these meals, and particularly the Presbyterian Church individuals and families who are ultimately responsible for this popular initiative. 
