#### An update from the Winton Community Support Worker : Louise Faithful



I had the opportunity last week to sit in on a presentation about a new personal alarm known as the GPSOS. The team at GPSOS have listened to stories around the concerns for vulnerable older people, those endeavouring to manage Alzheimer's and dementia, for people 'at risk' of other medical misadventures and those living in fear of domestic violence.

After two years of working with international designers and IT engineers the GPSOS is now available to support people in all lifestyles. The pendant has key features

such as, a panic button, two-way communication, fall detection and advanced GPS tracking. A GPSOS watch is also available however up until recently the GPSOS have just been available in the North Island.

From the demonstrations that I saw this alarm is going to far outweigh any other personal/medical alarm that is currently available. Most medical alarms only work within the boundary of your home, the GPSOS will work where ever you are, even if your away on a bus trip or in another town. The people monitoring the alarm know exactly where you are when you push the button and need help!

If you have a family member or friend living with dementia that is prone to wandering this alarm with its GPS technology will allow them to be found quickly and accurately. These alarms are already being used by people in all walks of life, not just for medical reasons. I believe one of these alarms would make a great Christmas gift for an elderly person to give not only them but also family members some piece of mind if they live alone or are often out and about.
